

Health Professions Graduations Data Dashboard, 2008-2023

HOW TO USE THIS DATA DASHBOARD

Dashboard Buttons and Dropdown List

- Use the large button in the top left corner of the dashboard to toggle between displaying the “Total” number of graduations and the “Rate” of graduations per 100,000 population for both the map and the first line graph below the map. This button does not affect the CIP code information or the information displayed in the Sex or Race/Ethnicity line graphs.
- Use the Profession dropdown to select the profession information displayed in the CIP code information, the map, and each of the line graphs.
- Use the State dropdown to display graduation information for the state selected on the map. Choose “(All)” to compare information for all states or select a specific state to display information for that state. Selecting a specific state will also restrict the information in each of the line graphs to the state selected.

CIP Code and Award Level Information

- The CIP code information (located directly below the Profession and State dropdowns above the map) displays the CIP code(s) for the profession selected as well as the minimum education requirements and the award level code(s).
- Detailed CIP and award level code information can be found in the document linked below the dashboard.

Map

- The map displays total graduations or rate of graduations by state (including Alaska, Hawaii, and Puerto Rico) for the profession and year selected.
- Use the dropdown menus above the map to select the Profession and State and use the dropdown menu in the upper right corner of the map to select the year.
- The color of each state signifies how high or low the total/rate of graduations is for that state compared to all other states during the year selected. The darker the shade of blue, the higher the total/rate. (Refer to color legend in the lower right corner of the map.)
- You can also hover over a state to display the year, total, and rate of graduations for that state.
- Click on a state (or use the lasso feature in the upper left corner of the map to select multiple adjoining states) to display specific information for that state/s in the 3 line graphs located below the map.

Line Graphs

- The first line graph below the map displays the Total/Rate of graduations by year for the profession selected in the Profession dropdown at the top of the dashboard. The second line graph displays the Sex breakdown by year and the third line graph displays the Race/Ethnicity breakdown.
- Hover over a dot on the line graph to display information for that specific year. For the Sex and Race/Ethnicity line graphs, this information will include a bar graph showing the sex or race/ethnicity breakdown during that specific year.

Of Note

- If a particular state is not displaying information for a given profession in a given year, this means the data is not available. Try a different profession or a different year.
- Race/ethnicity data is only available from 2011-2023, so keep this in mind when viewing the race/ethnicity line graph.
